NCS Chinese Department

1. On 29/1/2014, the NCS Chinese Department took 5A students to visit the Hong Kong Heritage Museum. Through visiting different exhibitions, such as New Territories Heritage Hall, Cantonese Opera Heritage Hall, T.T.Tsui Gallery of Chinese Art and 'Bruce Lee: Kung Fu . Art . Life', the activity enhanced students' understanding of Chinese art, culture and social development in Hong Kong.
2. From 28/1/2014 to 29/1/2014, the NCS Chinese Department organised a Chinese New Year Fai Chun (Spring Couplets) activity so as to enhance NCS students' understanding of Chinese culture and allow them and local students to enjoy writing Fai Chun.

Liberal Studies Department

1. The Liberal Studies Club participated in the 'Environmental Conservation Inter-school Forum' debate competition, organised by the 'Liberal Studies TV' of the RTHK, and won the 1st runner-up.
2. The Liberal Studies Department received subsidies from the Environment and Conservation Fund and the Environmental Campaign Committee to install a wind and solar renewable energy system in school. The solar and wind energy system has been functioning so as to enhance students' understanding of Green energy and its applications, promote energy conservation and build a green campus.

Visual Arts Department

From 3/3/2014 to 7/3/2014, the Visual Arts Department organised a Visual Arts graduation exhibition for S.6 students to show their work over the past three years and share their joy of producing artwork with teachers and students.

Information and Communication Technology Department

Eight 5A students who are studying Information and Communication Technology (ICT) participated in the Internet Safety Ambassador Training Group. After ten sessions of training, the ambassadors organised an internet safety exhibition and some booths to help the NCS students to learn about internet dangers and know how to use the internet safely.

Civic and Moral Education Team

1. From November to February, the junior form students have completed some chapters of the 'Basic Life Skills Training' course of the 'Adolescent Health Programme', including Communication Skills, Stress Management and Healthy Living (S.1); Listening and Anger

Control (S.2); Learning and Money Management (S.3).

2. On 28/1/2014, the Civic and Moral Education Team organised a Red Cross blood donation. 40 teachers and students successfully donated blood on that day.
3. On 13/2/2014, the Society for Truth and Light organised a sex education workshop, 'Homosexuality and Human Rights', for S.4 local students and the Society of Rehabilitation and Crime Prevention prepared a sex education workshop, 'Journey of Intimacy (II)', for S.4 NCS students so as to establish proper sex concepts in senior form students.
4. From 14-16/2/2014, the Civic and Moral Education Team organised the 'Future Leader Scheme' leadership training camp to enhance students' leadership through different activities. The third stage, shadow apprentice, will be held in the second term. Students completing the course can choose one leader position and become a shadow apprentice to learn how to become a leader.
5. From 10-13/3/2014, the Civic and Moral Education Team organised a flower show for students who have participated in the Flower Planting Activity to show their flowers and compete for the Flowery Award. Students who submitted their flowers before 7/3/2014 can join the flower show and obtain a Lift Me Up card. The inter-class Flower Photography Competition will be held in the same period. Students are welcome to join.

Career Guidance Team

1. On 24/1/2014, 14 students of the photo taking class and make-up class did voluntary work at the Yan Oi Tong Elderly Centre (Yuen Long) to provide make-up and family photo taking services for low-income families in the district so as to apply what they have learnt and serve the needy.
2. On 14/2/2014, the Career Guidance Team took 43 S.4 students to visit the New Senior Secondary Applied Learning Course Exhibition so as to enhance their understanding of Applied Learning (ApL) courses and help them to choose suitable courses for their further studies or future employment if they decide to take ApL as their elective subject.
3. On 20/2/2014, tutors of the Bridal Academy held a talk for S.4 students about the newly risen wedding related industries, such as wedding photography, wedding planning, etc.
4. On Parents' Day on 23/2/2014, the Career Guidance Team prepared an exhibition about further studies and future employment. The team also met some parents and answered some questions about further studies and employment.

Discipline and Guidance Team

1. From 22/1/2014 to 24/2/2014, the Discipline and Guidance Team organised the 'Public Transport Travelling Group' for NCS students to let them know how to take public transport and visit different places in Hong Kong so that they can learn more about Hong Kong.
2. On 18/2/2014, the Discipline and Guidance Team prepared the 'Internet Crisis' exhibition and booths during lunch time to teach students how to use the internet properly.
3. From late January to March, the Discipline and Guidance Team conducted the 'Assessment Program for Affective and Social Outcomes' (APASO) survey in the school.
