

Student Health Service "Online Enrolment Programme 2026/2027"

Dear Parents,

The objectives of the Student Health Service are to safeguard both physical and psychological health of students through health promotion and disease prevention services. Our scope of service covers health assessment which includes physical examination, growth and puberty assessment when necessary, individual health counselling and health education. Student Health Service is free of charge to students who are "eligible persons" (Please refer to "Notes for Parents/Guardians" for eligibility). You may refer to our webpage (www.shs.gov.hk/healthprog.pdf) for details of our health programmes. We are now conducting enrolment exercise for the 2026/2027 school year. Annual health assessment is provided for all primary and secondary day school students. The service period spans from November 2026 to October 2027. We would like to invite your child to participate in the service.

This year, both online and paper enrolment options are available for your convenience. **Parents may choose either one to enroll.**

Online Enrolment

Parents access the enrolment platform with the school specific access link or QR code and submit your application online from 1 September to 14 September 2026. Paper Enrolment

On 15 September 2026 (Tuesday), the school will distribute paper application forms to students who have not submitted an e-application. Parents using the paper form should complete the attached 'Application & Consent Form for Student Health Service 2026/27' and return it to the class teacher by 21 September 2026. If you do not wish to enroll your child this year, please complete **Parts A and C** of the form and return it to the class teacher."

Appointment Arrangement

Enrolled students will be given an annual appointment at a designated Student Health Service Centre. An appointment slip will be sent to you through the school approximately one month before the appointment date. Students in S1 to S3 participating in the student health service will be accompanied by teachers on a free bus provided by the Department of Health from the school to the student health service center for health assessments. Parents of S4 to S6 students are required to arrange their own transportation to the designated center for health assessments. Students are required to bring along the identity document for checking while attending the centre. Service may not be provided if there is no identity document on the date of appointment and rescheduling of appointment is required.
