Dear Parents,

Vaccination is one of the most effective ways to prevent seasonal influenza and its complications. In order to protect the health of students and facilitate vaccination of students, the School has joined the 2026/27 Seasonal Influenza Vaccination School Outreach Programme. The Department of Health(DH) has matched our School with Gold Coast which will provide free seasonal influenza vaccination outreach service to the School. The details are as follows:

Remarks:	1. Students have to bring along the original identity document (ID card). 2. Students have to bring along the original Seasonal Influenza Vaccination Card (If any). 3. Students are advised to have breakfast on the vaccination day. 4. Those students who are not vaccinated due to absence from the School or being assessed by the medical staff as unsuitable for vaccination on that day, no mop-up dose will be provided at the School. 5. Some students may experience fever, muscle pain, and tiredness beginning 6 to 12 hours after vaccination and usually lasting up to two days. If fever or discomfort persists, please consult a doctor. Immediate severe allergic reactions like hives, swelling of the lips or tongue, and difficulties in breathing are rare but require emergency consultation. 6. Students should consult your family doctor on the suitability for vaccination, if necessary. 7. To facilitate the collection of consent for the Seasonal Influenza Vaccination (SIV) School Outreach Programme, the Department of Health has introduced an Electronic Consent Form (e-Consent) this year. Parents/guardians may submit their consent for influenza vaccination by scanning the school's designated QR code through the eHealth.

**The following important information:**

1. The deadline for submitting the e-Consent is 13 September 2026 (Sunday). After this date, the parents/guardians will no longer be able to submit the e-Consent.
2. Both of the parent/guardian and the student must have an eHealth account in order to submit the e-Consent via the QR code. If you have not yet registered for an eHealth account, please complete the registration as soon as possible.
3. The e-Consent is only available for parents/guardians who consent to receive influenza vaccination. There is no "Refuse" option in the electronic system.
4. On 15 September 2026 (Tuesday), the School will distribute paper consent forms to the students who have not submitted the e-Consent as well as students aged 18 or above. Parents/guardians who do not submit the e-Consent may indicate a decision using the paper consent form when it is distributed.
- 5. Parents/guardians who have successfully submitted their consent electronically will not receive a paper consent form.**

Please return the reply slip to the class teacher by 15 September 2026. Parents who participate in this scheme using a paper consent form should submit it by 22 September 2026. Should you have any enquiries, please contact Miss Wong Yee Man at 2471 2622.

Electronic Consent Form

Background

To facilitate parents in submitting student consent forms for the Seasonal Influenza Vaccination School Outreach Programme (SIVSOP), the Department of Health (DH) will implement the “Electronic Consent Form for SIVSOP” in the 2026/27 season.

Advantages of e-consent



Convenient and fast

- Submit e-consent forms anytime and anywhere, eliminating the trouble of filling out paper forms.



All-in-One Management

- Easily access child's vaccination records and health data anytime through the "eHealth" App.



Minimize Human Errors

- Avoid omissions or illegible handwriting when filling out paper consent forms.



Earlier Outreach Activities

- Collect the list of students consenting to vaccination early, allowing outreach activities to be held sooner.

How to Submit e-Consent

- Both parents/guardians and their children/wards **are required to register an eHealth account**.
- Schools will distribute **QR codes** to parents between mid-August and September (subject to school arrangements).
- Parents/guardians scan the QR code **via the eHealth app** to submit the electronic consent form for their children/wards **under the age of 18**.

Electronic Health System (eHealth)

Developed by the Hong Kong Government, the Electronic Health System (eHealth) provides an electronic platform that aims to build up free and lifelong electronic health records for all members of the public. All persons (including school children) holding valid supporting documents can join eHealth.

eHealth Account Registration Methods

- You can register on your own, if you are **aged 16 or above (including students who are aged 16 or above)**
- **Parents of children under 16** can also download the eHealth mobile app and register as users of both eHealth and eHealth app. They can then use the “My Family” function to simultaneously register their child for eHealth and add them as a family member.

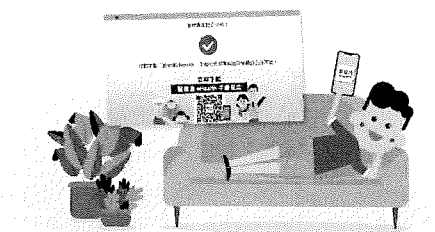

Online Submission

You can register with the Electronic Health System (eHealth) online.

If you submit your application with “iAM Smart”, identity verification and eHealth registration can be completed online at the same time. Your eHealth account will be created instantly.

You will need to complete identity verification at eHealth registration location in-person later if you are not using “iAM Smart”.

Online User Manual and Video

Step 1	- Schools will issue a school-specific QR code to parents. Please do not share this QR code with others. - Parents log in the “eHealth” app, scan the QR code to complete the electronic consent form. 
Step 2	- Please double-check the school name and select the child attending that school. If necessary, parents may also add their child as a family member here. - Please read the Points to Note and check the Vaccine Recipient Particulars 

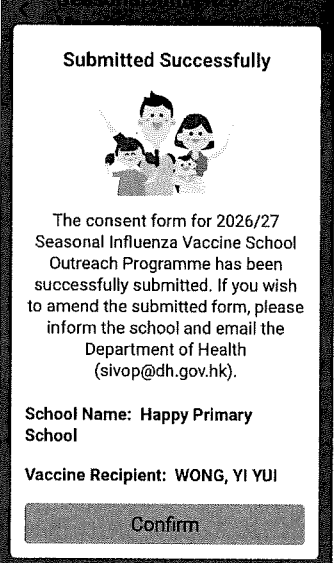
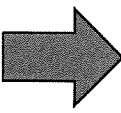
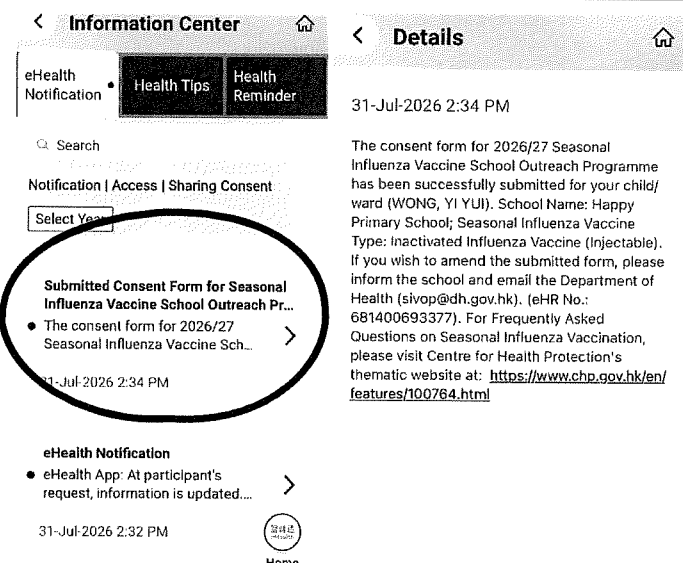
Step 3	● Please provide your child's class and student number for the new school year and indicate whether they have previously received the influenza vaccine. You may proceed with the submission if your child has not yet received the influenza vaccine for the current season.  
Step 4	● Please fill in the relationship to the vaccine recipient (parent or guardian) and the contact telephone number, and verify your personal details.  

- Step 5
- Schools may choose to use the injectable vaccine, the nasal spray vaccine, or the hybrid mode (use both injectable and nasal spray vaccines).
 - The system will only provide the type(s) of vaccine(s) selected by the school for parents to choose from. Please be sure to read the relevant vaccine information and pay attention to the situation which a person should not receive vaccination.
