Outdoor Learning Day is a learning activity and therefore full attendance is required. If a student cannot join the activity due to some special reasons, he/she must submit a written application to the class teachers in advance. However, he/she should come to the school as usual and stay on the campus on that day. The school will arrange some teachers to supervise those students to do study and homework. For causal leave, prior approval from the school is required. A medical certificate is required for sick leave. Any students who fails to comply with this rule will be treated as truant.

To facilitate the activity and ensure safety, students should follow rules under our instructions. Parents are cordially invited to inform your child(ren) of the following measures:

- (1) To be considerate. Students should be self-disciplined and behave themselves during the activity.
- (2) Students should not take part in any water activities, swimming, rowing, fishing, rock climbing, caving, cycling, etc.
- (3) Students should obey orders from the teacher and stay in designated areas. They should not leave the group during the activity.
- (4) If there is an accident, students should report to the teacher immediately.
- (5) Students should follow the traffic arrangements given by teachers.
- (6) When it is about time to leave, students should return to the rally point on time. If a student arrives at the rally point after the class has left due to some special reasons, he/she should stay at the rally point and wait for the teacher.

For teachers to recognise students and for safety reasons, the school has the following guidelines on clothes:

\*\* If a student violates the guidelines on clothes, he/she must stay behind in school instead of joining the activity.
