

# Application for Senior Secondary Applied Learning(ApL) Courses (2020-22Cohort)

Dear S.4 Parents,

Applied Learning (ApL) courses are elective subjects within the senior secondary curriculum. ApL offers studies with equal emphasis on practice and theory linked to broad professional and vocational fields. A flexible combination of ApL with core subjects, elective subjects and Other Learning Experiences helps provide students with holistic learning. Students can apply for studying ApL courses in Secondary 5 and 6, and opt to take a maximum of two ApL courses (excluding Applied Learning Chinese (for non-Chinese speaking students) (ApL(C)) as elective subjects, for the details of the course, please refer to <Attachment 1>.

In order to let students choose suitable courses, the school recommends that students should attend the following Taster Programmes before the application, in view of the development of Covid-19, the Taster Programmes will be conducted through the online mode to facilitate the current Secondary 4 students to make informed choice about Applied Learning courses. Please go to the EDB APL website <a href="http://www.edb.gov.hk/apl">http://www.edb.gov.hk/apl</a> to access to the relevant online resources provided by the course providers.

Students who are interested in Applied Learning courses MUST apply through the school and the applicants will be further selected by the course providers. Because of the limitation on resources, the school selection committee will make the final decision after considering the students' academic results, conduct, teacher reference and comments of the Career Guidance Team. If students enroll in the courses successfully, they will have to follow the rules of the course providers. For details and regulations of the application, please refer to <Attachment 2>.

## **Senior Secondary Applied Learning Courses (2020-22)**

## 1. Position of APL in NSS curriculum

• Applied Learning (APL) is an integral part of the New Senior Secondary (NSS) curriculum. APL complements senior secondary subjects.

## 2. Courses Design and Areas of Studies

- The design principle of APL courses is the same as that of other school subjects, with equal emphasis on the development of knowledge, skills and attitudes. APL aims at enabling students to understand fundamental theories and concepts through application and practice; and to develop their generic skills in authentic contexts; as well as to explore their orientation for life-long learning and career aspirations.
- The duration of each APL course is 180 contact hours, generally extending over two school years from Secondary 5 to 6.
- In the 2020-22 school years, a total of 36 APL courses categorised under the following six areas of studies will be offered by the 11 Course Providers approved by the EDB:

## 3. 6 Areas of Studies:

- Creative Studies
- · Media and Communication
- · Business, Management and Law
- Services
- · Applied Science
- · Engineering and Production

#### 4. Courses

## 5. Modes of Implementation

- Our school chose Mode 1: Courses take place at the venues of Course Providers and are taught by the tutors of the Course Providers. Our school will only accept students taking courses on Saturday morning and afternoon.
- In most of the courses, applicants will be selected by individual / group interview, using interests, aptitudes, abilities, languages and interview performances as the selection criteria.

## 6. Assessment, Quality Assurance and Recognition

- APL courses do not have public examinations. Assessments of student performance, including both <u>formative</u> and <u>summative</u> assessments, are undertaken by Course Providers and administered mainly by the respective course tutors.
- The Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority (HKEAA) is responsible for the moderation of the assessment results submitted by the Course Providers. The moderated results will be recorded on the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE) certificate.

## 7. Reporting of APL Courses Results

• The Apl results are recorded in the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE). Effective from the 2018 HKDSE Examination, the reporting of students' performance is refined to 'Attained', 'Attainted with Distinction (I)' and 'Attained with Distinction (II)' for the purposes of further studies and/or work. Performance of 'Attainted with Distinction (I)' is comparable to level 3 while 'Attainted with Distinction (II)' is comparable to level 4 or above of Category A subjects of the HKDSE Examination.

## 8. Subsidy

- School will not charge students any fees for taking APL courses.
- Students can only receive subsidy for at most one APL course.

# 9. Application Procedures

- All students MUST apply through the school for enrolment in APL courses.
- Application period for APL courses (2020-22) is from 5/5/2020 to 11/5/2020. Late applications will not be accepted.

#### 10. Selection and Admission

- Because of the quota, APL courses applicants must go through the selection procedures. The school selection committee will arrange interviews (if applicable) for APL course applicants in early April.
- Successful applicants will be nominated by the school to go over the enrolment procedures.
- Course Providers will also arrange interviews for all applicants on 11/5/2019 and 18/5/2019.
- Students MUST attend both the interviews of the school and of the Course Providers. Absence from the interviews will forfeit the application.
- The EDB will announce the enrolment results around June, 2020

## 11. Responsibilities of the Enrolled Students

- To avoid wasting resources, enrolled students should complete the two-year course and should not withdraw.
- Students should actively participate in lesson activities, complete the homework, be punctual and apply for their leave according to the requirements of the Course Providers.
- Students MUST attend lessons and related learning activities given by the Course Providers. The minimum attendance requirement is 80%.
- If students absent without any reasonable reasons, this would be affected students' school attendance and students need to suffer the school penalty.
