## Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) Arrangements of Class Resumption

Dear S.1-S.5 Parents,

The Education Bureau (EDB) has announced that schools in Hong Kong can resume classes by phases in a gradual and orderly manner. To minimise the risk of infection and facilitate schools' cleaning of their premises, all schools should only provide half-day classes. Therefore, please see the arrangements of our school as follows:

### 1. Class resumption of S.1 - S.5 classes

## 2. S.1 & S.2 online lessons

The S.1 & S.2 online lessons will take place in the afternoon from (\*27 May 2020 – 5 June 2020) due to the commencement of class resumption of S.3 - S.5 students. All S.1 and S.2 students should stay at home and attend the online lessons during the \*said period. More information concerning the new lesson timetables will soon be disseminated. Please pay close attention to the school website and eClass parent app.

## 3. Final Exam and Supplementary Tutorial Classes

## 3.1 Final Exam:

The S.1 - S.5 Final Exam will be held from 6 July 2020 - 16 July 2020.

## 3.2 Supplementary Tutorial Classes:

The S.4 - S.5 supplementary tutorial classes will be held from 27 July 2020 - 31 July 2020. Students should attend the classes for preparing and tackling the DSE exam. More information will be disseminated in due course.

# 4. Closing Ceremony & Last Day of School

Closing Ceremony: Closing Ceremony will be held on 24 July 2020 (Fri).

#### Last Day of School:

S.1, S.2 & S3 students:	24 July 2020
S.4, S.5 students:	31 July 2020

## 5. After-school activities during the class suspension period

All the after-school activities originally scheduled during the class suspension period will be cancelled.

## 6. Anti-Epidemic Measures of the School

The school premise (including the air-conditioners and air-conditioner filters in all the classrooms and special rooms) has been cleaned and disinfected thoroughly during the class suspension period. Alcohol-based hand dispensers have been installed in every classroom and also on each floor to enhance the measures for disease prevention. All students, parents, visitors, teachers and staff will be requested to check their body temperature at the school entrance. If they have a fever or any respiratory symptoms, they must not enter the school premise.

### 7. Reminders for students when entering the school premise

Students should wear proper summer school uniform to attend classes. Parents should check their children's body temperature before going to school and the temperature record sheets (refer to appendix) should be signed and returned to the school. Students should return home if they have a fever, any respiratory symptoms or if they are feeling unwell. Students should stay in the medical room until they are picked up by their parents. In addition, students should go back to their own classrooms immediately after entering the school premise and please note that no assemblies will be held in playground or school hall.

### 8. Anti-Epidemic Measures of students

Students should maintain good personal hygiene and stay vigilant at all times since it is still too early to say that the epidemic is under control. Therefore, parents should pay attention to the latest information disseminated on the EDB and school website.

Home-school cooperation is of paramount importance to foster a safe and clean learning environment for each student. Hence, please implement the following:

- 1. Pay close attention to the health condition of your child and seek medical consultation when your child is feeling unwell.
- 2. Check the body temperature of your child every day. Make sure the temperature record sheet is signed and returned to the school.
- 3. Ensure your child wear a mask before leaving home.
- 4. Fill in the electronic declaration form for travel history and health status of your child before class resumption. Please provide the following information:
  - Travel history in the past 14 days
  - Whether your child has confirmed infection of COVID-19
  - The health status of those taking care of your child /those living with your child
  - Whether your child has met (the close contacts of COVID-19 patients) in person
  - Current health status of your child

Please ensure you child complete the electronic survey as instructed by the class teacher before the class resumption. Students who are feeling unwell or still undergoing the 14-day home quarantine should not enter the school premise.

- 9. Please contact the school office at 2471 2622 if any of the following is verified.
  - 1. Your child has confirmed infection of COVID-19.
  - 2. The Centre for Health Protection has identified your child as a close contact of COVID-19 patients.

Let us pray for all students, parents, teachers, staff and Hong Kong citizens. May God bless everyone with good health and the epidemic can soon be eradicated.
