Reminders of Zoom lesson

- 1. Online classes are conducted through ZOOM real-time online conferencing. In order to enhance learning effectiveness, the school will strictly keep a record of the students' attendance, learning attitude and homework assessment. Each student's performance will be used as a reference for their promotion criteria. Parents should urge your children to abide by the rules.
- 2. Please help your child update the version of the ZOOM application to ensure a smooth and safe operation of the software. For the operation of the ZOOM application, please visit the school's website and download the relevant teaching guidelines.
- 3. In order to protect students' eye sight, students should not use mobile phones to participate in the online classes. If necessary, parents can prepare electronic devices with a large and clear screen, with camera and microphone that function normally to ensure online classes can run smoothly.
- 4. Teachers will assign homework information through the eClass platform or the school website. Parents should urge their children to study hard.
- 5. Should you have any enquiries related to students' learning, please feel free to contact the teachers of our school.
- 6. Parents can browse the school calendar on the school website to understand more about the school activities.
- 7. The online real-time video class is a regular class. Students should pay attention and be as active as they would be in school classes.
- 8. The ZOOM meeting ID and password of each class will be sent to the students via the eClass application, students should pay attention to the message before any lesson.
- 9. Students are required to log in to the ZOOM meeting ID and password assigned by the subject teacher on time according to the timetable. They can enter the class after the teacher gives permission.
- 10. Students should appreciate the values of learning, working hard and handing in their homework on time. If they fail to complete their assignments according to the instructions, they will be punished and there will be follow-up actions.
