

## **Jockey Club Coding for Community Project**

Dear S.3 Parents,

To cultivate students' digital literacy in face of the technological society, the school has been collaborating with the Center for Information Technology in Education (CITE)<sup>1</sup>, Faculty of Education, University of Hong Kong, and Youth Global Network (YGN)<sup>2</sup> to implement the "Jockey Club Coding For Community Project" (C4C) in S.3 classes. This project combines computer coding courses and adult-youth partnership programs to enhance students' computational thinking skills, programming knowledge, and facilitate students to establish positive and caring values for society.

Objectives: To help students to gain positive values and attitudes in learning, relating to

others and facing life, and actively search for one own path.

Target: All S.3 students

**Mentor Source:** School alumni, Yuen Long Kam Kwong Church and YGN volunteers

**Content:** Students will utilize the coding knowledge they have learned in class to design

and make a mobile app. "Mentors" will provide students directional guidance.

Students and "mentors" will learn together through collaboration.

Format: "Mentors" will meet with students in small groups (1: 4-6 ratio) and will

communicate and encourage them through social media.

Remarks: A. The Mentoring Program is an extension of the secondary Form 3 computer

lessons.

B.Students must wear neat sportswear to attend the following four activities.
