



Dear S.6 Parents,

The details of the S.6 Final Examination are listed below. It is hoped that parents can prod their children to prepare for the examination:

1. The S.6 Final Examination will be held from 22/1/2024 to 2/2/2024. During the examination period, students should come to school and go to the examination venue by 8:10 a.m. Moreover, students are reminded to arrive at the examination venue at least 15 minutes before each examination session. Please refer to (Annex 6C) for the exam timetable.
2. Casual leave for students during the examination period will not be allowed except for special cases. During the examination period, no matter how short the sick leave is, students have to fill in the Application for Leave column in the Student Handbook and submit a medical certificate. If a student is absent from an examination without following these procedures, he/she will receive zero marks in that subject. Absentees will not be given a make-up examination. Nonetheless, absentees should still apply for leave as stated (please refer to the Student Handbook) and submit the leave application documents to the class teacher on the next school day. The examination scores of absentees who follow the correct procedures will be estimated based on their daily marks.
3. The S.6 Exam Script Review Days will be held from 5/2/2024 to 7/2/2024. Students should come to school and have lessons as usual according to the timetable.
4. If the EDB announces a class suspension during the examination period, the examination(s) on that day will be rescheduled and it will be announced later. The remaining examinations will be held in accordance with the original schedule.
