If tested positive, they must not go to school but should inform their schools of their positive results as soon as possible and stay at home. They should also report to the Department of Health as soon as possible within 24 hours via the "Declaration System for individuals tested positive for COVID-19 using Rapid Antigen Test" (https://www.chp.gov.hk/ratp/).
- 3. Parents/Guardians should record their children's temperature and results of RAT daily, and sign on the record sheet. The record sheet should be returned to school staff/class teacher for checking.
