1. Date and Time:

14 July – 6 August	Bridging Course & Classes	Arrive at school before 9:30 am

2. Students should form a good habit of being punctual. Please leave for school early to make sure you can arrive at school before the designated time.
3. Bring the necessary stationery every day, including pens, pencils, a ruler and a rubber, etc.
4. Keep yourself clean and tidy. Wear lightweight casual wear to make yourself comfortable for activity. You should not wear any flamboyant, shabby or provocative clothes. Please note the requirements:
 - i. No dying or hair extensions
 - ii. No accessories (e.g. rings, bracelets, earrings, ear pins)
 - iii. No make-up and nail polishing

5. Please read the details (timetable and programme rundown overleaf).
6. Venue for classes and activities: Classroom, School hall, covered playground or open areas.
7. Please follow the following procedures for taking leave:

A.	Casual Leave	Inform the General Office in written form 3 days in advance. In case of urgency, call the General Office on the day, and submit a letter for Leave of Absence when you return to school.
B.	Sick Leave	Call the school at 2471 2622 before 9:00 am and submit the medical certificate and sick leave letter when you return to school.
C.	Early Leave	Students who have to leave early for urgent issues or due to not feeling well have to obtain a provisional application for Leave of Absence from the General Office. Students have to inform their class teacher and have the form signed and then return it to the General Office. The school will inform student's parent. After obtaining the parent's approval and having the application stamped with a school chop, students can leave early. Students have to return home immediately, and are not allowed to wander around. A parent letter is needed for the leave and has to be submitted when students return to school.

8. Students who are late have to fill in a form and submit it to the General Office for stamping and their class teacher for recording. The record will be kept. If students are more than 30 minutes late, it will be regarded as absence, and a letter for Leave of Absence is needed.
9. Students should actively participate in all activities and finish all the assessments.

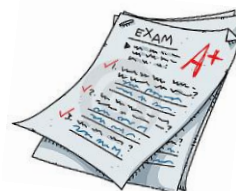

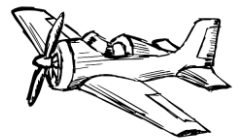

Fight the epidemic together !

- Students must measure your body temperature before returning to school
- Students should not go back to school if you have fever and respiratory symptoms
- Use alcohol handrub to clean your hands when entering campus
- Wash your hands frequently
- Pay attention to personal hygiene
- Students cannot gather, keep proper social distance (at least 1 meter)
- Wear a mask correctly
- The partitions in the classrooms help prevent the spread of epidemic and must be used carefully
- Only eat and drink within the designated area of the covered playground
- No eating or drinking in other places, including classrooms, corridors, playgrounds, tables and chairs near the flower bed or riverside, etc.
- Students should refrain from talking when their masks are taken off when having meals
- Students should not share tableware, food, and drinks.
- Students should store their masks properly and put them back on immediately after finishing meals
- Students should maintain social distancing while within the school campus including in queueing at tuck shop. Queueing is arranged in 2 rows, each row should have 3 people
- Students should keep a proper social distancing with other students when they are queueing up for toilet. Students should use the washrooms which on the same floor of their classrooms



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
